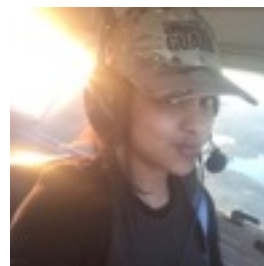

## Member Spotlight ~~ Angela Leedy



We are so lucky to have such a great group of female aviators in the Keystone 99s and we have a new member who is a super passionate ball of aviation fury! Angela Leedy has an amazing story. She flew her plane, the Cubcrafters Top Cub, to the 43rd Annual Sun n Fun 2017 where she was interviewed with the Florida Aviation Network (FAN). She talked about her amazing journey as an aviator and a group she created called The Hive.

During her interview with FAN, she was asked what brought her to aviation. Unlike many women in aviation who come to flying through family relationships and like-interests, Angela, with no background or exposure of any kind in aviation, simply wanted to overcome a fear of flying; an “extreme fear”, she emphasized in her interview. So she arranged to fly with a friend who owned a “super safe” plane and she conquered her fear of flying in a Super Cub. After that, she decided to continue flying and sought instruction at Aeroflex-Andover Airport, (12N), Andover, New Jersey.



She flew with one of the best Tailwheel Instructors in the country, Mr. Damian DelGaizo, from Andover Flight Academy, and her instruction was in a Piper J3 Cub.

*“He has been the most positive influence in all my training so far. He somehow manages to work through all my difficulties applying analogies so fitted to my personality that I am amazed at every flight we endeavor. Only a genuine caring instructor could pull that off. I am looking into buying his Top Cub which I hope to happen very soon as I also want to do my check ride in the Cub.”*

Since then, Angela bought her first airplane, the Cubcrafters Top Cub, which is a solid 180 horsepower with a climb prop and big tires!



Aircraft that Angela has had the wonderful opportunity to fly since the Super Cub include a Stearman and a B-25! Now that alone makes her my hero!

When asked about how she started the network group, The Hive, Angela explained that she was at a Fly Out and met a woman who told her about another Fly Out in Georgia. This gave her the idea of connecting aviators (women and men) by giving them a central location to share and post aviation events nationwide.

Currently 175 members strong and growing, Angela signs each member up as an event organizer so that they may be encouraged to post and share events. She even goes so far as to hold monthly contests where she asks for sponsors! One such event was a free ride in a B25 and another a free ride in a Stearman! Whoever posted the most events in a single month won these flights! Another contest was simply the 100th member contest. The 100th member received a prize! When asked in her interview with FAN about how, as a New Jersey resident with seasonal weather concerns, how does she maintain her sharp pilot skills? "I fly all year round and flew 130 hours last year!" She added that not only is it important that she keep her own skills sharp, it is also very important to keep the engine running properly. She is always planning a flight somewhere and The Hive keeps her planning.

When asked about her thoughts about Women in Aviation, she replied, "*Fly with me*" and encourages young women to fly with her. She invites anyone interested to fly with her when she has an empty seat in her Top Cub! She is passionate about encouraging and inspiring confidence in women of all ages. Angela even goes as far to put her phone number out there and invites anyone to call her with questions, direction and encouragement!

What's next for Angela? She is currently working on her Aviation Maintenance Professional (AMP) and has a goal to land in every state! She eventually wants to head out west, Idaho to be precise, to learn bush/mountain/backcountry flying. Her goal is to fly Alaska next year with a fellow female aviator friend!

Angela Leedy, a woman of style and spunk, wearing furs and heels, who says, "anything men can do, we can do better in heels!"

It is amazing to me that she started with no exposure and with an extreme fear of flying but with the desire to conquer her fear, found passion in the challenge and accomplishment! The skies hold no limit for Angela Leedy!
